After lunch, continue exploring secluded beaches around the harbour, many of which are wonderfully private and only accessible by boat. Either bask in the sunshine on the spacious yacht deck and sun beds or enjoy a refreshing dip in the ocean off the swimming platform.

Today will be met at your accommodation at 9.30 am by your Splendour host and private transportation. Discover one of the world's most ancient cultures, first-hand through the eyes of a local Australian Aboriginal person, a respected member of the Bundjalung nation, and your guide for the next 2 hours.

Your Splendour host will take you directly to some of Sydney's most beautiful green spaces, rich in Aboriginal history and native plant life. Join your Aboriginal guide here and discover the captivating history of the oldest living culture on earth.

Walk 'on country' and learn how colonization transpired in Australia and what that meant to the indigenous culture that lived on the land at the time. Connect to the spiritual richness of the culture – take part in a traditional Welcome to Country ceremony, formally blessing you to walk the land. This is your opportunity to open your mind and soul to the learnings of the land and 'caring for country'.

Over morning tea, taste traditional recipes as well as contemporary creations using native ingredients such as lemon myrtle, wattle seed and macadamia nut oil.

After an enriching and soulful two hours, say goodbye to your Aboriginal guide and head to lunch – wherever possible we'll choose a café or restaurant with cultural significance to open your mind further to modern indigenous culture in Australia.

After lunch, visit Aboriginal art galleries in Sydney with your Splendour Host. This could be at Yiribana, within the Art Gallery of New South Wales or privately owned commercial Indigenous galleries around Sydney.

Your host will return you to your hotel at approximately 2.30 pm.

Despite being so young on a global scale, Sydney's architectural story is incredibly rich and diverse. Your host is a spunky award-winning Architectural Urbanist, passionate about all things design, who will provide you with a real sense of the city's orientation, settlement and evolution.

Your host will meet you at your hotel at 9am for your experience focused on discovering the city's architectural gems. This is a walking tour, covering anywhere between 2-5kms, so be certain to wear your most comfortable shoes and to apply sunscreen on the day.

Your day will start with an architectural bang - visiting Jørn Utzon's famous Sydney Opera House, which is perhaps Sydney's most renowned and most beautiful architectural destination. Along the way, you'll hear about how famous international architects have moulded and played an important role in the development of the city and you will visit iconic buildings such as Custom's House, the Museum of Sydney and the Department of Lands. Your host will make certain you don't miss a thing - leading you through the city loop which takes in Australia Square, Martin Place and Bligh Street. Another fact you will learn is that Sydney-siders take their coffee very seriously. Visit a quintessential Sydney café to enjoy an outstanding coffee and morning tea treat.

As you discover the city's architecture you'll notice that the buildings themselves are not characterised by one architectural style but are an extensive and layered juxtaposition of old meets new - from the sandstone Victorian buildings to the modern high rise buildings which grace the city's centre. At the tail end of the tour you will swap the city streets for the majestic Royal Botanical Gardens, passing ancient trees and Aboriginal sacred sites, all enhanced by the iconic harbour views.

The final stop today will be a local restaurant for some well-deserved Sydney rock oysters and champagne with your host. Toast to an amazing day of discovery and local connections. At the end of the tour your host will escort you back to your hotel or you may wish to stay put and enjoy the area further.

Best known for its sparkling beauty and energy, Sydney is a sight to behold, rich in local history and wonder - best experienced with the right host. After departing the airport, first venture towards the iconic coastline, weaving your way through the picturesque Eastern Suburbs from Coogee Beach to Bondi Beach, where you will get a feel for the famous Australian surf and swim culture.

You will then head north along the harbour peninsular and stop at Dudley Reserve for uninterrupted views of Sydney Harbour, visiting the infamous Gap. This will lead to Rose Bay, the site of Australia's first airport, checking out the country's most luxurious harbour suburbs of Vaucluse and Point Piper.

Explore the vibrant suburbs of Darlinghurst, Kings Cross and Potts Point on foot at your leisure with your host. By early afternoon you may be ready for another bite and curious to try more Australian cuisine - stop for a quick and light lunch at one of our favourite local eateries – to be decided on the day.

Dry off and stop to enjoy a delicious breakfast at a Bondi café popular with locals. If you haven't experienced an Aussie bacon & egg roll yet, we insist on trying it today! Browse through stunning aerial beach shots taken by photographer Eugene Tan of the area you are exploring today. You may even want to take a memento home with you.

It's then back to the sandstone coastline to embark on the picturesque journey from Bondi Beach to Coogee Beach - the views along the way are absolutely breathtaking and you'll want to stop for many a beach snap of your own. You'll pass many neighbouring beaches along the walk, one of which is beautiful Bronte Beach, home to a striking rock pool, once an Aboriginal birthing site. Take a break here to enjoy a refreshing swim, in either the ocean or the rock pool.

Continue along the boardwalk from Bronte to Clovelly, past Gordons's Bay and then on to Coogee. Once at the vibrant Coogee Beach, take a well-earned break and indulge in a gourmet lunch and delicious cocktail at the iconic Coogee Pavilion rooftop terrace overlooking the coastline. Enjoy a gourmet two-course lunch with a glass of crisp local wine or Aussie beer in a beautiful picturesque mountain setting. Savour being out in nature and relish in the local cuisine while gazing out over the striking bush escarpment.

Today you will be met at your Sydney hotel by your specialised Splendour host and private vehicle for your exclusive full day tour of discovery in Sydney's Ku-ring-gai Chase National Park, dining on the Hawkesbury River and flying high above Sydney Harbour by seaplane.

Ku-ring-gai Chase National Park is one of Australia's oldest National Parks. The natural and rugged beauty of the landscape is sure to wow you. On your tour you will venture off the beaten track and be immersed in the wilderness in this incredible bushland setting. Your hike adventure will begin with a relatively easy hike to West Head Lookout. Prepare to be impressed – the views from the lookout are some of Sydney's best - see Broken Bay on your left, Pittwater on your right and Barrenjoey Headland and Lighthouse in front. You can also enjoy amazing vistas across the Hawkesbury River to Lion Island Nature Reserve and the beaches of the Central Coast, including Patonga and Umina Beach. The lookout itself is a large sandstone viewing area, rest on one of the benches and absorb the sounds of the birds and waves below before heading to nearby Resolute picnic area for lunch or taking a walk on the Aboriginal Heritage walk (2km return). The Aboriginal Heritage Walk combines Resolute and West Head walking tracks. Along here, you'll encounter historic rock engravings and art of the Guringai people, the traditional owners of this land. Within a 10-minute walk along the track, you'll come across the best-known site in the park, Red Hands Cave filled with ancient Aboriginal art. Nearby, as you continue on the track, there are impressive ancient rock engravings.

For lunch today, your host will escort you to Cottage Point Inn. This magical dining venue may just be twenty minutes by seaplane from Sydney's CBD, but you'll feel worlds away upon arriving at this unique restaurant on the Hawkesbury River. This is your opportunity to leave the hustle of Sydney behind as you stop to enjoy a leisurely, 5-course degustation lunch with outstanding, privileged views. A feast much appreciated after a wholesome morning hike. For those old enough, choose the perfect wine to accompany your meal from a wide variety of exceptional Australian wines. \*drinks to be purchased directly upon consumption

As your transportation back to Sydney after lunch, we've arranged a scenic seaplane flight so you can truly experience Sydney from above. Fly along the rustic sandstone coastline and into Sydney Harbour. Observe the harbour from all angles taking in the iconic real estate, pristine beaches and turquoise water. Land at Sydney's seaplane terminal (the site of Australia's first airport) where your host will be waiting to drive you back to your hotel.
